

California Archery Hall of Fame Qualifications for Candidates

- #1. To be considered for nomination, a resume of the candidates achievements must accompany the nomination, preferably on the standard resume form provided by the CA HOF committee, but it may be submitted on plain paper, typewritten. All information submitted must be specific as to dates and places and it becomes the property of the CA HOF and will not be returned.
- #2. A legible resume must be on file with the CA HOF before an individual will be considered.
- #3. Candidates must be a resident of the State of California at the time of nomination or have been a resident while achieving her or her accomplishments.
- #4. Candidates must have performed outstanding achievement in shooting of bow and/or promoting archery in California. Said candidate must have given much more of himself/herself than the average archer or affiliate.
- #5. A nominee must have achieved his/her accomplishments five (5) years prior to nomination, the exception being an individual that has brought world recognition to California archery. This shall not exclude someone still active in the sport of archery.
- #6. If possible, a picture shall accompany all resumes.
