RATIONALE: (Describe existing problem and expected benefit of proposed change)

There is currently no active program in California to prepare archers for the expectations and demands of a state tournament nor one that encourages the next generation of archers to compete. To provide a comfortable place for this growth we are proposing a model based off what one of the regions in the state is currently doing with the addition of a league and regional competition.

New item: Revision: X. Bylaws: Standing Rules: X. Page # 28 Article # III, Sec A.

A. The acknowledged State programs shall be: Hunting Activities, Field Archery, Flight, Target and Indoor Archery, and Bowhunter Education, and the State League.

Proposed change or addition: (Must be EXACT wording)

New item: X. Revision: Standing Rules: X. Page # 28 Article # III, Sec C, 5.

5. The State League will consist of mail in matches for the State Indoor, State Unmarked 3D, State Field, and State Target. Points will be awarded to regions based on the number of archers in their region who participate as well as based on if the archers in their region placed. More points will be allotted to minors who participate. Perpetual awards will be awarded to the winning region for each league as well as a perpetual award to the region with the highest aggregate of points.

a) For the State League, the cost will be \$15 per bow style for the first tournament starting with the State Indoor, and \$5 for each additional league tournament. The archer will receive a lanyard and a pin for participating or for placing in 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in their respective category. If the archer intends to compete in different bow styles in more than one League, the archer will need to pay \$15 to receive an additional lanyard.

b) Awards will be given out for all age divisions, female and male, and in all CBH/SAA recognized bow styles. Archers will be limited to compete in their natural age division.

c). One score will be submitted for each of the league tournaments and must be shot in accordance with NFAA regulations with the exception being the State Unmarked 3D (see d). All scorecards submissions must include the region the archer is competing for. For the State Indoor League, the tournament must be shot over November 1st to January 31st. Indoor League scores must be submitted by February 15th. For the State Field, the tournament must be shot over April 1st to June 30th. Field League scores must be submitted by July 15th. For the State Target League, the tournament must be shot over July 1st to September 30th. Target League scores must be submitted by October 15th. For the State Unmarked 3D League, the tournament must be shot over March 1st to November 30th. Unmarked 3D League scores must be submitted by December 15th.

d) State Unmarked 3D League will be shot in accordance with IFAA's 3-D Hunting Round (1 Arrow). Only targets without an orange dot may be used. No range finders allowed. See current list of which target may be used for each of the Target Group Numbers 1-4.

e) Each region will be allotted points based on the following participation breakdown: 3 points for every archer age 11 and under; 2 points for every archer ages 12-17; 1 point for every archer 18+. If a regional archer places, the following point system will be used instead: For every archer 11 and under, 6 points for coming in 1st, 5 points for placing in 2nd, 4 points for placing in 3rd. For every archer 12-17, 5 points for coming in 1st, 4 points for placing in 2nd, 3 points for placing in 3rd. For every archer 18+, 4 points for coming in 1st, 3 points for placing in 2nd, 2 points for placing in 3rd. An additional point will be allotted to every female archer that competes.

f) Lanyards, pins, and regional perpetual awards will be sent out to one club in each region. Each region is responsible for determining which club assume this role for the year.

g) Winners will be listed in the Newsletter as well as the CBH/SAA website. The regional perpetual award winners will be recognized at the banquet (typically held in February).
