

#1. To be considered for nomination, a resume of the candidates achievements must accompany the nomination, preferably on the standard resume form provided by the CAHOF committee, but it may be submitted on plain paper, typewritten and double spaced. All information submitted must be specific as to dates and places, it becomes the property of the CAHOF and will not be returned.

#2. A legible resume must be on file with the CAHOF before an individual will be considered.

#3. Candidates must be a resident of the State of California at the time of nomination or have been a resident while achieving his or her fame.

#4. Candidates must have performed outstanding achievement in shooting of bow and/or promoting archery in California. Said candidate must have given much more of him/herself than the average archer or affiliate.

#5. A nominee must have achieved his/her accomplishments five (5) years prior to nomination, the exception being an individual that has brought world recognition to California archery. This shall not exclude someone still active in the sport of archery.

#6. If possible a picture shall accompany all resumes.
